Mumbai – The Megapolis

- Financial Capital of India
- Cosmopolitan nature
- City of dreams
- Covers an area of about 437.71 Sq.Km.
- Merger of 7 islands in city area and 4 islands in suburbs.
- Population density of about 27,209 people per Sq.Km.



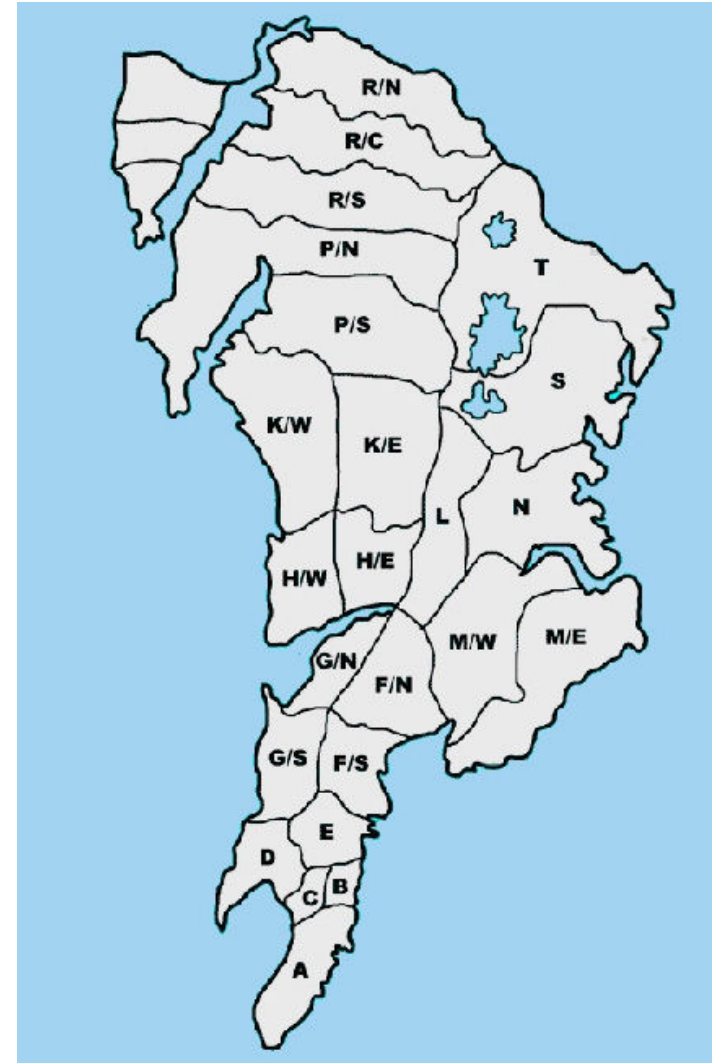
Mumbai – The Megapolis

- Mumbai's suburban rail systems carry a total of 2.2 billion passengers every year.
- Total of 3500 BEST Buses with a daily average of 45 Lakh passengers



Mumbai – The Megapolis

- Greater Mumbai is divided into 6 zones, around 24 wards named alphabetically:
 - **Zone 1:** Ward A, B, C, D, E
 - **Zone 2:** Ward F South, F North, G South, G North
 - **Zone 3:** Ward H East, H West, K East, K West
 - **Zone 4:** Ward P North, P South, R Central, R North, R South
 - **Zone 5:** Ward L, M East, M West
 - **Zone 6:** Ward N, S, T



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Issues Facing Mumbai

- Population of 19 million!
- Huge migrant population
- High population density
- Infrastructure under tremendous pressure
- Flood prone
- Soft target for terrorist

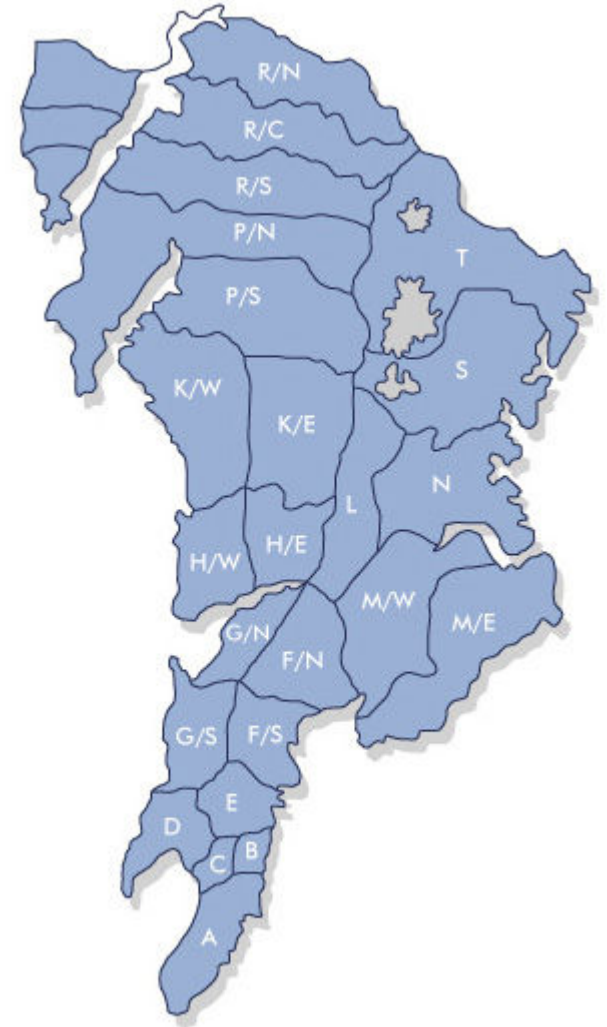
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Micro approach to a mega problem

- Divide and rule!
- Handle disaster preparedness one ward at a time
- Revive ALM concept
- Adopt the Public Private Partnership approach
- Address disaster preparedness one ward at a time
- Support of key Government bodies like MCGM, Police and most importantly ***We the Mumbaikars!***



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Next Steps

- Formation of Core Group
 - 5 -7 member team from Government and Corporate
 - Lay down 7 point action agenda and norms
 - Empower and monitor progress
 - Selection of Private organization to parent / adopt wards
 - Approach MCGM, Police etc for support
- Agenda would include awareness, education and training such as:
 - Emergency Medical
 - Combating threats such as Fire, Earthquake etc
 - Organizing public awareness session with help of Fire Brigade, Police etc.



Next Steps

- For each ward selected Parent Organization will form team of volunteers:
 - Own Employees
 - Colleges / Charitable organization
 - Government officials local Police, Ward Officer, Corporate,
